The fruits to remind us of the blessings which flow from God to us.

In this service we shall be thinking particularly about the red ribbon of Jesus's ministry, and we shall put up a red ribbon round the church to remind us of Jesus's birth, life, death and resurrection.

For the kingdom, the power and the glory are Yours, now and for ever. Amen


